

Worship Team Guidelines

Purpose- to respond to God for who He is thru music, video, and drama.

Requirements for Praise Team

1. A regular attendee at CCC for a minimum of 6 months.
2. A life-style that is continually growing to conform to the image of Christ.
 1. A good testimony to the body (the church family). Cheerful . . . considerate . . .caring (not proud or boastful).
 2. Praise Team members are the most visible leadership of the Worship Ministry. Desiring to be above reproach, we would ask that each member commit to living a life above reproach. (putting family first, a growing relationship with Christ, leading by example at home, work, and play, conscience of words and actions)
 3. A cooperative spirit within Praise Team. Not everyone can play/sing every week. Attitude is more important than ability.
3. Faithful attendance of services whether you sing/play or not.
4. Apparel that does not distract is very important. Please adhere to the following;
 - o Easy! . . . Nothing Short/Nothing Tight!
 - o LADIES: Slacks/Skirts/Dresses – Well below the knee!
 - o MEN: No shorts, t-shirts, or flip-flops.
5. Give of time to prepare and rehearse music outside rehearsals.
6. Attend other opportunities of service outside of the church.
7. Acceptance of the style of music used, but not afraid to offer tasteful opinions.

Rehearsals

Rehearsals are only 1 1/2 hours per week. That is SO little for such important work. Two things are required for every rehearsal:

Great Attitude!

ON TIME Arrival!

Make a habit that on time is 5 minutes early! In case you must be absent . . . you need to call or email Jay.

Praise Teams rehearsal – Thursday 6:30-8 in the sanctuary

Worship ensemble- as needed

Qualities needed for singers;

1. A blending voice.
2. Flexible for differing styles.
3. Ability to understand music and pick out harmonies by ear.
4. Can memorize music.
5. Must sing straight tones. Vibrato will make a voice stand out.
6. Sing center of pitch-not below (flat) or above (sharp).
7. Energized voices and body language that expresses love of God.

Qualities needed for players;

1. Willingness to use personal instrument. Instrument must be of good quality that sounds great when ran thru house sound.
2. Flexible on many styles.
3. Ability to read chord charts and transpose on the fly.
4. Ability to play with a group/team.
5. Ability to express love for God thru body language(No shoe-gazers or blank faces).

Media Ministry

One of the fastest growing areas of ministry in the church is media. God created light, beautiful sights and sounds; and He created us to worship Him! So, it is certainly fitting that we use these elements in worshipping God. At Christ Community, we use audio, video and lighting systems to enhance and give clarity to our worship services and special presentations. We use volunteers, who work behind-the-scenes with servant's hearts, to run these systems. The areas of service include audio, camera operation, video editing and graphics, lighting, media duplication/distribution, and stage set-up.

Getting connected with the Media Ministry is easy. No experience is needed; we train everyone. Our volunteers work two Sundays a month, as we value giving them the opportunity during the other weeks to worship with their friends and family.
